DELAY OF TRAIN – a direct cause in the delay to train crew operations, during normal switching services.

# **SECTION 2 - SWITCHING**

Item 215 – Delay of Train

In the event a OERR train and/or engine and crew is unable to perform switching service, or work is impeded due to causes attributable to a customer or industry, the following charges will apply:

- 2.) Subsequent quarter hour charges following initial delay...... \$100.00 per each ¼ hour These delays include, but are not limited to: rails blocked or fouled, derails, switches, or gates locked, cars in process of being worked, inspected or sealed, or other customer request leading to delay.
